Parks Primary school's SPS has declined. The goal is to grow and regain our SPS letter grade of an A. Currently the state predicts our score for 18-19 to be a
90.1 A (official scores do not come out until October) 90.1 is a 4 point drop from
the previous year. Parks Primary's goal is to grow to a 92.1.
SCHOOLWIDE PLAN GOALS 1 AND 2 (ELA & Math)
ELA Goal: By Spring 2020, ELA Index will increase from _85.1 to 86.7 Targeted vocabulary and clarification strategies will be taught school wide. Data driven strategy. Implementation of a Remediation Block.
MATH Goal: By Spring 2020 Math Index will increase from _91.2 to _92.9 Problem solving and calendar math will be utilized school-wide. Problem solving and calendar math will serve as a period of spiral review for students. The skills focus will be based on IReady Data, LEAP data and weekly assessments.
SCIENCE Goal: By Spring 2020 Science Index will increase from _79.7 to _83 Through the implementation of PHD Science and hands on Science experiments, the students will apply understanding of social studies content and concepts by expressing and developing claims that make connections and/or show relationships among ideas and Science topics. SOCIAL STUDIES Goal: By Spring 2020 Social Studies Index will increase from _67.7 to _70.7

SWIP goals given to Leadership team. Grade levels will analyze their areas of weakness and come up with an individualized grade level reflection/plan. In weekly Cluster meetings, teachers will analyze student data to determine areas for improvement.
